**St Matthew's Pre-School** is a committee run group based in the centre of Redhill and is a registered charity. The group has been successfully inspected as Good by Ofsted 2017. At present we offer core sessions of:

## **Morning sessions Primarily for 3-4 year olds**

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 9.00am.to 12.00 noon.

## **Afternoon sessions Primarily for 2-3 year olds**

Monday, Tuesday, and Friday afternoons from 12.30 p.m. to 3.00 p.m.

We are also able to offer a very limited number of all day spaces from 9am -3pm on Monday, Tuesday and Friday.

**Our** aims are to enhance the all round development and education of pre-school aged children in a safe, secure and stimulating play based environment. We work within the EYFS framework ensuring equality of opportunity for all children. Each session is staffed by a minimum of 3 members of staff. Through the Key Person system we give children individual care and attention. We offer fun, friendship and an opportunity for you to be involved.

**Fees** are currently £4.60 an hour for funded aged children and £ 5.88 an hour for pre funded aged children. Fees are payable half termly **in advance**. Fees are **still payable** if your child is unable to attend for any reason e.g. sickness, holiday. Should your child leave, other than to start reception class, Pre-School requires a full half a term's notice in writing. Should this not be the case the appropriate fees will be due.

**Free Early Education** . We are eligible to receive funding for children the term **after** their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday. Children are funded the following term if they are 3 by December 31<sup>st</sup> March 31<sup>st</sup> or August 31<sup>st</sup> respectively. St. Matthew's Pre-school opens and claims for 38 weeks per year. FEET funding is also accepted should you qualify.

Our **admissions policy** is such that forms are dated when received. Paper forms are kept until your child is offered a place and are destroyed once your child starts or you decline the place. Places are offered regardless of nationality, religion or sex. Any child with Special Educational Needs will usually be offered a place following discussions with parents and health/educational specialists.

By returning this form, please use **BLOCK CAPITALS**, your child's name will be on our waiting list. It does not guarantee them a place at Pre-School.
